**APPROVAL FOR SUPPLYING SPECIFIC PATHOGEN FREE (SPF) SHRIMP
(*Litopenaeus vannamei*) BROODSTOCK INTO MALAYSIA**

With due all respect, we refer to the above matter.

2. We are pleased to inform that Department of Fisheries Malaysia has conducted documents audit and field audit on your premise base on MS 1998:2007 GAqP and approved P.T Bibit Unggul to supply SPF BROODSTOCK (*Litopenaeus vannamei*) to Malaysia.
3. This approval is subjected to these requirements including;
 - i. The approval only applicable for SPF BROODSTOCK (*Litopenaeus vannamei*) for five (5) years with provided to be reaudited every five (5) years from 1st August 2018 to 31st July 2023.
 - ii. The company are mandatory to submit an annual report of supplying a shrimp broodstock to any hatchery in Malaysia to Department of Fisheries Malaysia before 31st January each year.
 - iii. Any changes of hatchery structure of organization, layout design, construction of additional facilities in a hatchery need to be updated accordingly.
 - iv. The company are mandatory to submit an annual laboratory testing for SPF Pathogen to Department of Fisheries Malaysia within one (1) month before 31st January each year.
 - v. The company are mandatory to submit any latest document or certificate after renewal process to Department of Fisheries, Malaysia accordingly.



vi. The company are compulsory to ensure to supplying a broodstock to approved hatchery by Department of Fisheries Malaysia by requesting copy of valid quota document before send a broodstock into Malaysia.


